- 1. Contestant must be a member in good standing with the KAA
- 2. Contestant must be employed as an auctioneer at a livestock auction market located in Kansas
- Contestant must be endorsed by the facility owner or operating manager
- 4. Contestant does not need to be a resident of Kansas
- 5. Contestant must be one of the first fifteen entrants to submit completed entry form and entry fee, within the time allotted for entry
- 6. Contestant must pay Kansas Auctioneers Association an entry fee of \$100. Payable by money order or check
- 7. Contest is limited to the first 15 entries. The 16th, 17th and 18th entry will be held as alternates. In the event that 15 or more entries are received on the same day we will select contestants through a draw process
- 8. Entries open October 1st and close October 22nd for brochure inclusion
- 9. Entries must be received by US Mail. Completed Entry form and entry fee must be enclosed
- 10. Each contestant will sell eight drafts of cattle; one round only
- 11. A Trophy Buckle and \$500 to champion; \$400 reserve; \$300 runner up; 4th \$200; 5th \$100
- 12. Three Judges will be used to determine the winner
- 13. Winners will be announced at the conclusion of the competition and the Champion buckle will be presented at the Saturday night KAA Winter Convention dinner on January 24, 2015.
